Nov 1864 check for \$10,640.42 drawn on the account of Henry Chapman & Co, Montreal Canada (I believe they manufactured glass bottles). It had 1.35 in Canadian revenue stamps on the reverse, and was apparently presented for payment in NY City. A close inspection shows "Ten thousand" crowded onto the payee line, and another 10, crowded before the \$ sign. This is a fraudulent raised check and the crook was going for a big score. Many endorsements and notes, but still unclear to me if the scam worked or not. VF..... \$377.
