Silver denarius of Julius Caesar, 1st of the Twelve Caesars. 49-48 BC Obv: elephant trampling a snake Rev: implements of the high priesthood EF nicely balanced with old toning.... \$877.

Silver denarius of Augustus Caesar, 2nd of the Twelve Caesars Obv: laureate head of Augustus in high relief Rev: the small temple of Mars Ultor (the Avenger) built specifically to house the legionary standards recovered by Augustus from the Parthians, who had captured them by defeating Crassus and Anthony. On this coin the standards are in a chariot (Crassus?). Superb old toned EF..... \$1,277.

Gold aureus of Tiberius 14-37 AD 3rd of the Twelve Caesars Obv: laureate bust of Tiberius Rev: his mother Livia enthroned. Nicknamed the "Tribute Penny in Gold" Best style and surfaces which we have ever had. ICG AU 50..... \$5,700.

Issue by Tiberius in 36-37 AD to honor his deceased stepfather, Augustus. Obv: Shield inscribed OB CIVIS SER surrounded by wreath and supported by two Capricorns. DIVO AVGVSTO SPQR around Rev: SC surrounded by TI CAESAR...etc. Very pleasing EF..... \$3,700.

Bronze as of Tiberius 22-30 AD Obv: radiate head of his step father Augustus in fine style Rev: altar to the "Providence of Augustus" EF+ razor sharp detail dark slightly rough surfaces with partial highlights..... \$287.

Bronze as of Drusus, died 23 AD, was the son of Tiberius and his first wife Vipsania. Obv: his bare head Rev: legend VG+ \$67.

Bronze as of Tiberius c 34-37 AD Obv: laureate head of Tiberius Rev: rudder in front of globe F+ \$177. VG..... \$77.

Gold aureus of Caligula (Gaius) 37 AD Obv: bare headed bust of this infamous 4th of the Twelve Caesars Rev: radiate bust of Augustus, great grandfather of Caligula ICG Fine 15 (very PQ)..... \$8,777.

Silver denarius of Caligula 37-41 AD Obv: laureate bust of Caligula Rev: bare headed bust of his deceased father Germanicus VF, several digs and scratches on both sides, mostly in the fields..... \$1,477.

Silver drachm of Caligula 37-41 AD struck for Caesarea in Cappadocia with Latin legends. Obv: bare headed bust of Caligula Rev: priestly tools: ladle and curved staff VF, few minor defects..... \$1,477.

Bronze as of Caligula (Gaius) 37-41 AD Obv: portrait of this insane emperor Rev: Vesta enthroned Very smooth, even VF++..... \$677.

Brass dupondius honoring 2 deceased brothers of Caligula Obv: Nero and Drusus Caesars on horseback Rev: legend VG..... \$77.

Gold aureus of Claudius 41-54 AD 4th of the Twelve Caesars Obv: laureate head of Claudius Rev: Constantia seated VF rev slightly off center..... \$2,977.

Another as previous, nice even Fine..... \$2,477.

Silver cistophorus (3 denarii) of Claudius, 41-54 AD minted in Ephesus, Asia Minor. Obv: bare head of Claudius in fine style "TI CLAVD CAES AVG". Rev: COM ASI, Claudius in temple, crowned by goddess, ROM ET AVG inscribed above. Paul's visits to Ephesus were during the reign of Claudius, who had issued an edict expelling Jews from Rome. Silversmithing was an important craft of Ephesus mentioned in Acts 19:23-27 and the Roman coins minted there by Greek artisans often surpassed those of the Italian mint itself in quality and beauty. VF+..... \$1,277.

Silver denarius of Claudius Obv: laureate bust of Claudius Rev: Nemesis standing, holding caduceus, snake before Choice VF..... \$2,877.  
Another VF, slightly off center, oxidized surfaces..... \$1,077.  
Another Fine, slightly off center, few light defects..... \$677.  
Another silver denarius, Constantia rev. Fine, chip broken out of edge,..... \$377.

Gold aureus of Antonia, mother of Claudius, grand mother of Caligula Died 37 AD and honored on this coin struck 41-45 AD Obv: Draped bust of Antonia wreathed with grain ears Rev: Ceres standing, holding long torch and cornucopiae bold, even VF..... \$5,700.

Brass dupondius of Antonia Obv: her bust Rev: Claudius standing. VG..... \$57.

Bronze as struck by Claudius honoring his deceased brother Germanicus Obv: bare headed bust of Germanicus Rev: legend Wide VG+ rough patina..... \$47.

Brass sestertius of Claudius Obv: his laureate bust Fine style portrait. Rev: EX SC PP OB CIVES SERVATOS in wreath VF green patina but tiny obv and rev center drill holes.... \$477.

Bronze as of Claudius Obv: his bare head VF \$187. VG, held..... \$17.

Gold aureus of Nero Claudius Drusus, deceased, and now honored by his son, the emperor Claudius. Obv: laureate bust of Nero Claudius Drusus Rev: triumphal arch inscribed De Germ, surmounted by statue of Drusus on horseback wielding spear, flanked by military trophies with bound captive Germans beneath. This arch probably spanned the Appian Way just north of the Via Latina. VF nick on his cheek..... \$3,977.

Obv: bare head of Nero Claudius Drusus, deceased, and now honored by his son and emperor Claudius 41-54 AD Rev: Claudius, or Drusus? Seated on curule chair amidst pile of arms and armour, holding olive branch F++ choice original surfaces..... \$777.

Gold aureus of Claudius 50 AD Obv: laureate bust of Claudius Rev: bare headed draped bust of the young boy Nero, who was the son of Agrippina, Junior, niece of Claudius who married her uncle. Formally adopted by Claudius, there is some speculation that Nero was a biological son of Claudius. Very pleasing VF one minor edge split... \$3,977.

Silver tetradrachm of Antioch, struck by Nero 54-68 AD to honor his adopted father. Obv: laureate bust of Nero star behind Rev: laureate bust of Claudius VF thick, tight flan nice even gray toning..... \$477.

Gold aureus of Nero 54-68 AD 6th of the Twelve Caesars Obv: bare head of Nero as a young man Rev: EX SC in wreath surrounded by legend. VF..... \$2,977.

Brass sestertius of Nero 64 AD Obv: laureate bust of Nero Rev: triumphal arch surmounted by statue of Nero in chariot flanked by statues of Victory and Pax. This amazing edifice commemorated the Roman victory in 58 AD over the Parthian king Tiridates who occupied the throne of Armenia. It was apparently demolished after Nero's downfall. EF a few obv letters affect by corrosion spot..... \$1,977.

Brass sestertius of Nero 64 AD Obv: laureate bust of Nero Rev: Nero as cavalrman wielding lance, another soldier behind. Decursio describes rapid military action. VF slightly rough surfaces..... \$777.

Brass sestertius of Nero Obv: laureate bust of Nero Rev: Annona and Ceres EF/VF rough patina smoothed down..... \$877.  
Another G..... \$97.

Silver denarius of Nero 54-68 AD Obv: laureate bust of this infamous despot Rev: Jupiter enthroned EF..... \$877.  
Another F+..... \$347.  
Fine..... \$277.

Brass dupondius of Nero Obv: laureate bust of Nero Rev: Securitas seated EF/VF dark patina..... \$477.

Bronze as of Nero Obv: laureate bust of Nero Rev: temple of Janus even VG+ heavy patina..... \$97.

Brass semis of Nero Obv: laureate bust Rev: agnostic prize table F++ heavy patina \$77. another VG..... \$47.

Copper semis (large) of Nero Obv: bust of Nero Rev: agnostic prize table VF tooled heavy dark patina \$127.

Silver tetradrachm of Nero struck at the Antioch mint 54-68 AD Obv: laureate bust of Nero Rev: eagle standing on thunderbolt VF \$377. Fine \$117. G+..... \$77.
